



Worksheet: Provision Without Proof

Scripture Focus:

And he said, Thus saith the LORD, Make this valley full of ditches. For thus saith the LORD, Ye shall not see wind, neither shall ye see rain; yet that valley shall be filled with water, that ye may drink, both ye, and your cattle, and your beasts. — **2 Kings 3:17**

Part 1: Reflecting on the Word

1. **The Context:** In [2 Kings 3](#), the three kings were in a desert with no water for their army or livestock. What is the "desert" or dry season you are currently facing?

2. **The Instruction:** Elisha told the people to dig ditches in the valley before the water arrived. What is one "ditch" (an act of preparation or obedience) God is asking you to dig right now, even though you don't see the solution yet?

Part 2: Trusting the Unseen

3. **No Wind, No Rain:** God promised provision without the usual signs of a storm. Are you waiting for a "spectacle" (a loud sign or big miracle) before you trust Him? List one area where you need to trust God's "quiet faithfulness."

4. **The Purpose:** The water wasn't just for the kings; it was to sustain the entire valley and lead to victory. How might God's provision in your life benefit those around you?

5. **Write a Prayer:** (Example: "Lord, I trust Your hand even when I don't see the rain.")

- **Action Step:** What is one thing you can do this week to show God you believe His promise is already on the way?
